Minor and machinery in nature	This proposal is minor and has negligible regulatory costs  The permanent exemption from Trans-Tasman mutual recognition requirements will require beverage containers that are within scope of the Victorian Container Deposit Scheme (CDS), that are lawfully able to be sold in New Zealand, will need to comply with the labelling requirements of the CDS to be lawfully sold in Victoria.  The permanent exemption is not anticipated to have any impacts on persons, businesses, or government in Queensland.
