Minor and machinery in nature - Regulation	<p>The Regulation makes minor consequential amendments to align the <i>Energy (Infrastructure Facilitation) Regulation 2024</i> with the amendments made to the <i>Energy (Infrastructure Facilitation) Act 2024</i>. These include updates to references to amended or repealed sections of the Act and terminology. This proposal is minor and machinery in nature, having no regulatory costs for introducing consequential amendments.</p> <p>The Regulation also makes minor amendments to existing regulations to clarify and support the operation of the Priority Transmission Investment (PTI) framework. The PTI amendments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• update references to national assessment documents for development of Regulatory Investment Tests for Transmission to current versions to maintain the policy intent of consistency with the national framework• update transmission infrastructure projects prescribed as eligible PTIs, which relate to the former Infrastructure Blueprint, to reflect the energy priorities outlined in the Queensland Energy Roadmap• clarify technical issues in a section of the existing regulations that relate to administration of Regulatory Asset Base (RAB) allocation directions. <p>The amendments do not seek to materially alter the policy of these provisions. This proposal is minor in nature and is not expected to result in any material regulatory or cost implications.</p>
